Social Media Video Campaign

CNIC Registration Campaign

YDF team organized Citizenship Identity Card (CNIC) registration drives within minority communities in Lahore and Faisalabad. The goal was to ensure that eligible individuals had the necessary identification to exercise their right to vote.

Through these drives, the team successfully registered 300 individuals from minority communities, paving the way for increased representation in the upcoming elections.





Mock Voting Sessions to Enhance Understanding on Electoral Processes
